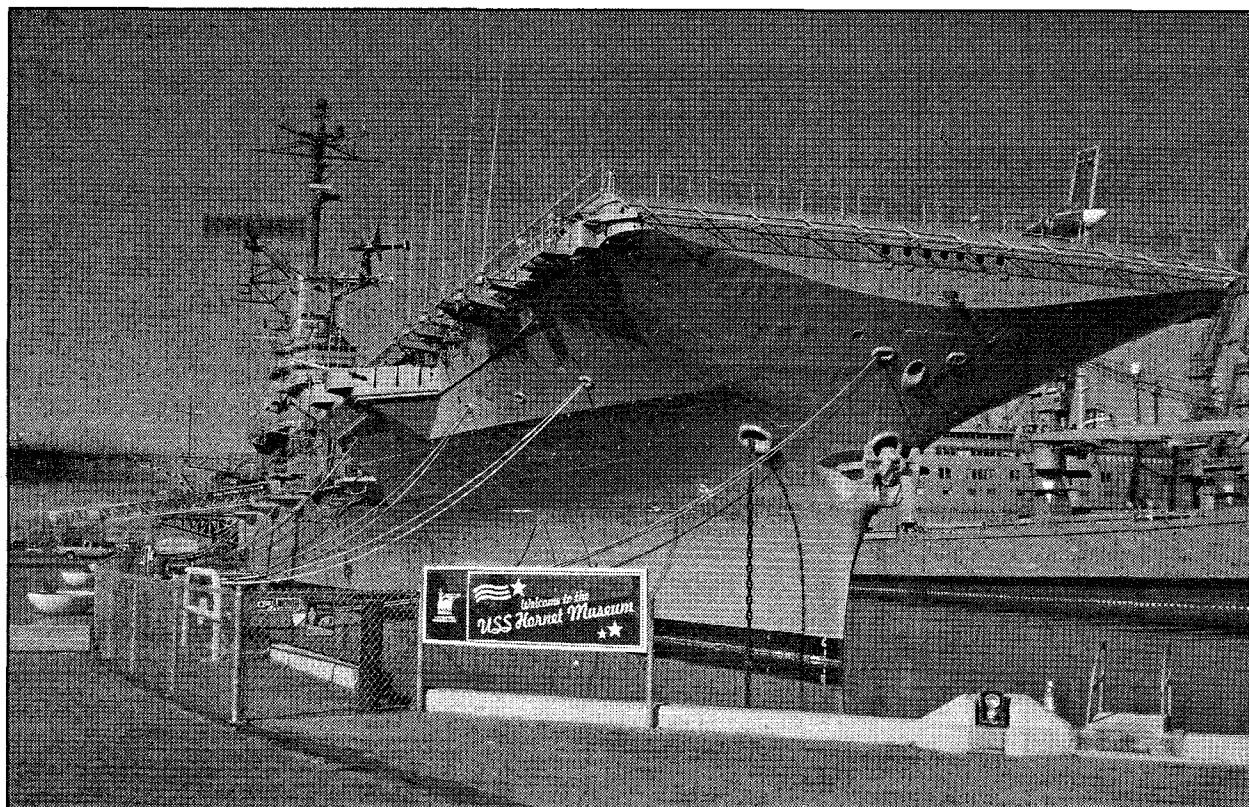

The following is a copy of a letter sent on August 16, 1945 to the Communication Department of the U.S.S. Shangri-La. This was sent to us by Association Member Fred Wilbur, SM3/c, a Plank Owner on board 1944-45.

**"U.S.S. SHANGRI-LA (CV-38)  
c/o Fleet Post Office  
San Francisco, California**

**August 16, 1945**

**FROM: COMMUNICATION OFFICER  
TO: ALL OFFICERS AND MEN - COMMUNICATION DEPT.**

1. It has long been the custom to pat each other on the back after a victorious achievement. The President, SEGNAV, COMINCH and COMTHIRDFLT have all given the Third Fleet a well done. VADM MCCAIN has given a well done to Task Force 38.
2. To bring it closer to home, I wish to say 'well done' to you for the fine work. The Force Communication Officer has told me that the Shangri-La has the smartest and best organized Communication Department of all the flat tops. That is as it should be.
3. Shortly, some of you will be headed home. All of you will be thinking about it. It is a pleasant thought. In the meantime, the Navy must go on and consequently we must carry on in the same style as before. We just pay particular attention to smartness in dress and material cleanliness. Let's take the Shangri-La home with all dials sparkling. Once again, well done, and thanks.

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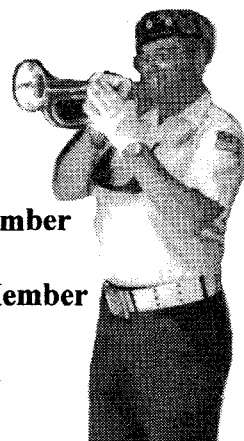

### **WINE COUNTRY TOUR**

***Wednesday, September 7***

Napa Valley's Mediterranean climate makes it the premium wine-growing province in North America. Along the way to the winery, we will drive through beautiful Sausalito with its charming architecture and breathtaking views. Visitors to St. Supéry Winery will find a warm, friendly welcome and an educational wine experience like none other in the Napa Valley. St. Supéry's knowledgeable staff will guide you through the history of winemaking in the Valley and offer you a glimpse into the future by viewing an ultra-modern winemaking facility. The most comprehensive offering is the guided tour of the Wine Discovery Center, which begins in the display vineyard; guests are free to wander among the vines, taste the grapes, and take photographs. A walk through Atkinson House invites guests to spend a moment in a bygone era in the Valley. Inside the winery, through meticulously designed exhibits, the visitor is introduced to the making of fine wines from the soil to the bottle. 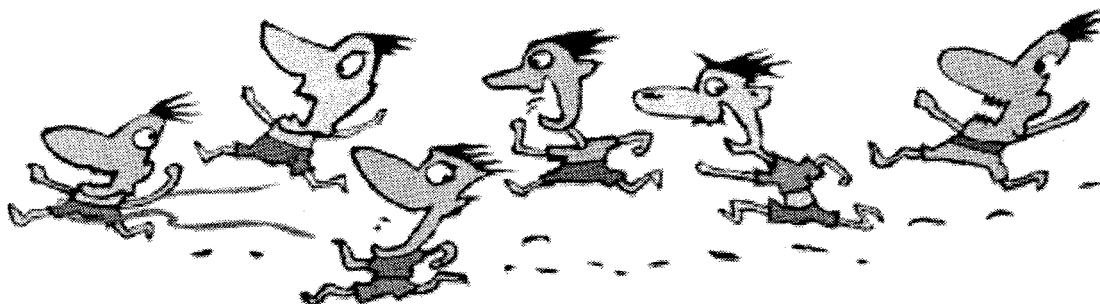
