The Metro is Washington DC's subway system.....it is the absolute best way to get around the DC area. I have used it in the past and you can go from one end of Washington to the other in very short time. Of course there are buses available and many different "see the sights" bus tour companies in Washington. Driving around in your own vehicle is another possibility, but you're going to find a LOT of traffic and parking is very difficult on the city streets....as I said previously, the Metro goes everywhere quickly, is inexpensive, and has stops within a short walk of all the popular sites to see. We have the added benefit of complimentary shuttle bus service from our hotel to a Metro stop only a few blocks from the hotel.

### **MEMORIALS TOUR / MEMORIAL SERVICE**

**Thursday, August 22**

See our nation's War Memorials during a driving tour of Washington, D.C. Stop at the Lincoln Memorial and visit the Korean War and Vietnam War Memorials. While at the US Navy Memorial, we'll conduct our annual MEMORIAL SERVICE and enjoy a maritime movie. Afterward, stop at the Ronald Reagan Building and International Trade Center, which is the largest building (3.1 million square feet) in Washington, DC and is the first and only federal building dedicated to both government and private use. While there, enjoy lunch on your own at the Reagan Building food court - named one of the "best family food courts" in DC. After lunch, a brief stop will be made at the World War II Memorial, the first national memorial dedicated to all who served during World War II.

**Note: A photo ID is required for entrance to the Ronald Reagan Building.**

The museum currently has over eighty aircraft and dozens of space artifacts on display including the Space Shuttle Discovery, an SR-71 Blackbird, the Dash 80 prototype of the Boeing 707, and the B-29 Superfortress "Enola Gay." Lunch options include a food-court style McDonald's and coffee place. You may tour the exhibits at your own pace, but there is a lot of walking, so please wear comfortable shoes.

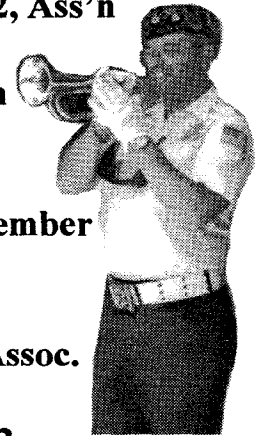
