

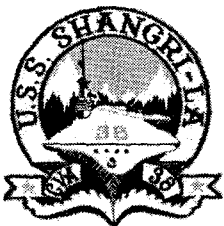

We hope you find it in your hearts and pocketbooks to be with us in San Francisco.

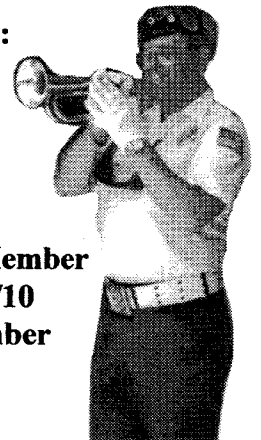

### **WINE COUNTRY TOUR**

Napa Valley's Mediterranean climate makes it the premium wine-growing province in North America. Along the way to the winery, we will drive through beautiful Sausalito with its charming architecture and breathtaking views. Visitors to St. Supéry Winery will find a warm, friendly welcome and an educational wine experience like none other in the Napa Valley. St. Supéry's knowledgeable staff will guide you through the history of winemaking in the Valley and offer you a glimpse into the future by viewing an ultra-modern winemaking facility. 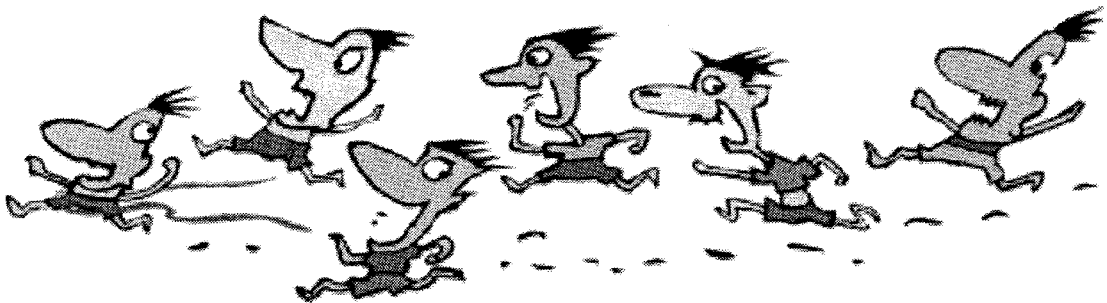
