

#### WINE COUNTRY TOUR

Wednesday, September 7

Napa Valley's Mediterranean climate makes it the premium wine-growing province in North America. Along the way to the winery, we will drive through beautiful Sausalito with its charming architecture and breathtaking views. Visitors to St. Supéry Winery will find a warm, friendly welcome and an educational wine experience like none other in the Napa Valley. St. Supéry's knowledgeable staff will guide you through the history of winemaking in the Valley and offer you a glimpse into the future by viewing an ultra-modern winemaking facility. The most comprehensive offering is the guided tour of the Wine Discovery Center, which begins in the display vineyard; guests are free to wander among the vines, taste the grapes, and take photographs. A walk through Atkinson House invites guests to spend a moment in a bygone era in the Valley. 
