The National Museum of the US Air Force (WPAFB Museum) is the world's largest military aviation museum featuring more than 360 aerospace vehicles and missiles from the beginning of military flight to today's stealth technology. The 19 acres of indoor exhibit space displays a B-2 stealth bomber, the B-17F Memphis Belle, a space shuttle exhibit and four of nine presidential aircraft in addition to thousands of personal artifacts, photographs and documents highlighting people and events including an excellent Doolittle Raiders & Vietnam Exhibit.

The Wright-Dunbar Interpretive Center & Aviation Trail Visitors Center, the Parachute Museum and the Wright Cycle Company offers an immersion of the history of aviation and the Wright Brothers most intriguing history which incorporates the Wright Cycle Company which financed the Wrights's Brothers continuous development of aviation.

<u>America's Packard Museum</u> displays cars ranging from 1903 to 1956 and is the only Packard museum operating out of a restored dealership. APM has the largest public collection of Packard autos and memorabilia in the world.

**The Huffman Prairie Flying Field** - The Field where the Wright Brothers honed their flying skills and later operated a flying school from 1910 to 1916. Today, the field remains much as it was when Wilbur & Orville flew their experimental airplanes over Torrence Huffman's pasture.

Carillon Historical Park is a beautiful 65-acres site showcasing Dayton's rich heritage that changed the nation and the world. The Park is home to the John W. Berry, Sr., Wright Brothers National Museum featuring the original 1905 Wright Flyer ill, the world's first practical airplane. Also featured is an impressive collection of NCR cash registers, a printing shop, a train & carousel ride, and many other interesting places to explore.
